

Genocide Memorial Day Poetry Competition Rules

- The competition is open to anyone aged 11 to 18 at the time of entering.
- The poem needs to be emailed to gmd@ihrc.org.
- Participants must be residents in the United Kingdom
- No IHRC employees or immediate relatives of IHRC employees can enter the competition.
- The poem must not exceed 400 words (excluding the title of the poem).
- All poems must include a title.
- All poems submitted must be typed in clear English, and every page should bear the name of the entrant.
- There can only be one entry per person.
- There can only be one author per poem.
- All entries will be considered anonymously by the judges.
- Entries will not be returned, so please keep a copy.
- Under no circumstances can alterations be made to poems once entered.
- All submissions can be used by IHRC as and when required.
- Only poems written in English will be considered in the competition.
- All entries will receive a confirmation e-mail, if you have not received a confirmation on receipt of your application please email and enquire about your entry at gmd@ihrc.org.

The competition organisers reserve the right to change the judging panel without notice and not to award prizes if, in the judges' opinion, such an action is justified.

The judges' decision is final and neither the judges nor IHRC staff will enter into any correspondence.
