

Yashar LaChayal is a unique organization, working tirelessly to provide combat soldiers in the Israel Defense Forces with the goods they lack - warm winter wear. toiletries, personal goods, water backpacks and other important items. As a result of annual support from a donor family that funds operational and administrative costs, 100% of funds raised through other sources are used to benefit the soldiers. In addition to providing soldiers with goods and services, Yashar LaChayal brings good wishes from all our supporters directly to the soldiers, raising morale by reminding soldiers that there is a huge wall of international Jewish support behind them

From its inception in July, 2006, during the height of the Second Lebanon War, Yashar LaChaval has been providing for the basic needs of Israeli soldiers. Initially, a small group of volunteers worked to collect and package much-needed supplies and transport them directly to the soldiers on the front. When the war ended, the volunteers continued to receive requests for supplies from army commanders. In response to this need, Yashar LaChayal was established as a recognized non-profit organization in Israel and the United States, dedicated to helping Israeli soldiers serving on the front lines and making them more comfortable while they are protecting the Jewish homeland. Our staff and volunteers go directly to the soldiers, assessing needs and then returning to fulfill them - Yashar LaChayal, Straight to the Soldier

- Bar and Bat Mitzvah Projects, providing young people with an opportunity to assist Israel's soldiers by developing a fundraising campaign of their choice and contributing to a specific Yashar LaChayal project.
- The Needy Soldier Supply Closets, providing soldiers in financial distress with personal goods and toiletries, such as towels, undergarments, shampoo and toothbrushes the necessities that are usually provided to soldiers by their families but are not readily available for needy soldiers.
- The Lone Soldier Fund, assisting volunteers in the IDF without immediate family in Israel by providing basic necessities, such as food coupons, beds and standard appliances, as well as a place to turn to for assistance and additional support when necessary.
- The Annual Winter wear Campaign, funding the purchase of thousands of fleece jackets, thermal underwear, gloves, hats and neck warmers for soldiers serving on the front lines.
- The Annual Water Backpack Campaign, funding the distribution of thousands of water backpacks for soldiers, making water quickly and easily accessible to soldiers while they are working in Israel's extreme heat.
- Food Packages for Families of Needy Combat Soldiers, distributed twice annually, for Rosh Hashanah and Passover, nourishing the bodies and the souls of many soldiers and their families.
- The Mishloach Manot for Soldiers Campaign provides opportunities for individuals around the world to sponsor Mishloach Manot packages that are sent directly to the soldiers on their army bases in remote and distant locations.

In addition to these campaigns and projects, *Yashar LaChayal* responds to requests from army commanders for specialized goods and immediate assistance. These requests range from the need for protective gear that is not provided by the IDF to urgent requests for personal goods for soldiers. In all these cases, *Yashar LaChayal* staff, volunteers and donors work rapidly and efficiently to assess the need and respond to the request.

From its inception in July, 2006, during the height of the Second Lebanon War, **Yashar LaChayal** has been providing for the basic needs of Israeli soldiers. During the war, the Moskowitz family of Miami Beach and a small group of volunteers worked together to purchase, collect and package much-needed supplies (basic toiletries, sunscreen, towels, undergarments and other necessities), and transported them directly to the soldiers on the front. On occasion, the volunteers themselves had to take shelter as katyusha rockets rained down. They drove far north, beyond the last civilian, to deliver supplies to the soldiers who were mobilized hastily and were running low on essentials. These volunteers met IDF units about to enter Lebanon, and sent additional supplies to soldiers deep in Lebanon.

This project, called *Operation Northern Points* by the volunteers, is documented by the photos below, taken from the car and near the front as the supplies were transported and delivered.

Operation Northern Points was made possible by the initial donation of the Moskowitz family who wrote that, "Our hearts and souls are with you" and looked to find a way to help the soldiers who risked their lives daily to defend Israel.

When the war ended, the volunteers continued to receive requests for supplies from army commanders. In response to this need, **Yashar LaChayal** was established as a recognized non-profit organization in Israel and the United States, dedicated to helping Israeli soldiers serving on the front lines and making them more comfortable while they are protecting the Jewish homeland.



Yashar LaChayal and army officials, enabling us to properly assess the needs of our soldiers and to fulfill them. Finally, Yashar LaChayal – Straight to the Soldier – means exactly that: we bring the goods to the army bases and speak directly with the soldiers, reminding them that we stand with them and that they have a huge wall of international Jewish support behind them.

Combat soldiers, the soldiers serving on the front lines to ensure Israel's security, are the primary focus of **Yashar LaChaya**'s services. We reach out regularly to units in the north, on the borders of Lebanon and Syria, those serving in the south on the Egyptian border, to soldiers on our border with Gaza, and to the Special Forces – the elite units charged with tasks critical to our national security.

Since the beginning of Operation Protective Edge, we drove supplies down to our troops, visited hospitalized soldiers, and made sure our IDF troops know that there are Jews all over the world that are standing by their side. Because of the exclusive connections we have forged with company commanders over the past eight years, we have been able to accomplish amazing things. They know us, they trust us, and they call on us to fill specific needs – whether it's food, toiletries, water backpacks, kneepads, leatherman tools, head flashlights, clothing, recreation equipment, and religious items. We met soldiers as they came out of Gaza, and we "debriefed" them on the needs and what we can do to make them more comfortable. terrible conflict to assess needs and bring exactly whatever supplies each unit so desperately needs – despite the constant Code Red alerts reminding us of the danger from overhead.

We gave out:

- * Thousands of underwear, socks, undershirts, hats, and dryfit shirts
- * Thousands of items including soaps, shampoos, towels, wipes, haircutting equipment,toothbrushes,toothpastes, powders and other hygienic necessities.
- *3000 water backpacks to over 15 different units
- *10,000 ices and 3000 cold drinks
- *200 coffee kits
- * 3000 thermoses which were filled up with ice and over 1000 travel pillows for the tank units

As you know, I'm now in training in the IDF. My unit is the 50th Battalion of the Nahal Infantry Brigade. As is well known in the States, the IDF is far from a wealthy army, with a lot of its materiel comes secondhand from the US. Our officers are given a finite amount of money, which needs to be stretched to cover as much as possible. Needless to say, some things fall through the cracks – our tents have holes, which let in rain and wind, many of our canteens leak or have holes and a large percentage of our combat vests are falling apart from wear. I can assure you that there is no shortage of needs in my company.

We are trying to raise money to buy items that will A) supplement our military equipment, B) make our lives a bit easier and C) free up company money to buy more modern gear. The main items that we would like to buy are:

– Fleeces – lighter and warmer than the winter gear that we were issued

- Camelbacks - backpack to specifically hold water. Enables us to carry more water, more comfortably (as opposed to canteens)

- Dry Fit Shirts - shirts specially designed for running and working out
