(GMD) poetry competition for young people of the ages between 11-18. This is a chance to encourage young people's literary abilities and creativity towards and around a theme of protecting humanity from genocide and acts of genocide.

IHRC set up GMD in 2010

believing it was imperative to set aside a day each year to remember the genocides, genocidal acts and genocidal policies of the modern era. The day is now commemorated in different parts of the world, usually on the third Sunday of January.



The poems submitted should be around the theme of protecting humanity from genocide and the poems should be appropriate and sensitive to the subject.

Paid trip to Bosnia with an accompanying adult. Includes flights, accommodation and meals. There they will be able to visit the sites of where some of the atrocities took place, and learn more about the events.
